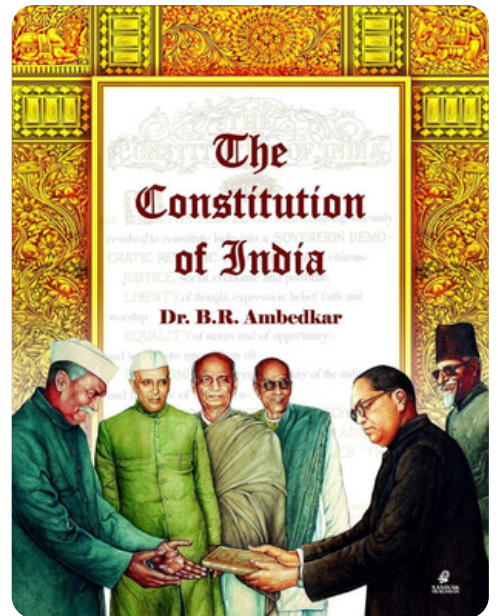
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REMEMBERING BHARAT RATNA

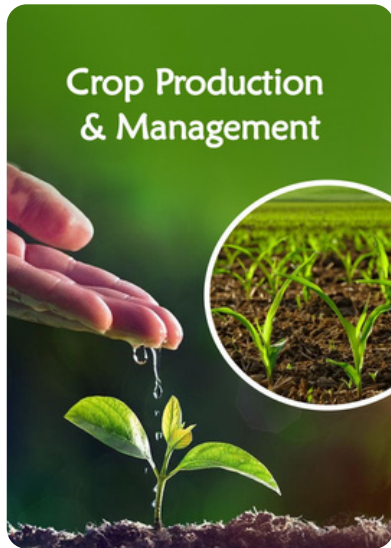
May Babasaheb's legacy continue in how we, and generations to come, cherish and follow the ideals enshrined in the Constitution of India.
