True patriots consider service to the nation as a form of "Karma Yoga" or selfless service. They do not harbour any negative emotions towards other nations, because their spiritual foundation tells them that all human beings are connected. However, they prioritize the "garden" that they were born to tend.

The Educated Spiritualist

Education prevents spirituality from becoming dogmatic. It allows a person to use reason to interpret ancient wisdom, applying spiritual principles to modern problems like climate change, economic inequality, or artificial intelligence.

The Educated Patriot

Educated patriots understand the constitution, the history, and the social and economic needs of their nation. They do not just wave the National Flag but they contribute fundamentally to nation-building through entrepreneurship, educating children, preserving culture and heritage, uplifting the downtrodden, embracing modern technology and drawing attention to issues that elevate the national discourse.

Challenges in Modern Times

In the 21st century, these three pillars of individual, institutional and national progress are under threat.

Materialism over Spirituality - The drive for "more" often replaces the search for "meaning," leading to burnout and a lack of social conscience.

Information over Education - We have more data than ever, but less wisdom. Digital echo chambers can stifle critical thinking that education is supposed to foster.

Jingoism over Patriotism - High-decibel nationalism often replaces the quiet, hard work of nation-building, leading to division rather than unity.

The Way Forward

To build a vibrant society and a progressive nation, we need to re-evaluate our approach to these concepts. We need schools that go beyond producing employees of the future, we need an education system that would prioritise the nurturing of spiritually conscious citizens of the future - citizens who would be more proficient and resilient in navigating their way through their personal and professional lives, and, therefore, be better equipped for achieving success. We need spiritual leaders who encourage civic engagement and we need political systems that recognize the fact that the strength of a nation lies in the character and intellect of its people.

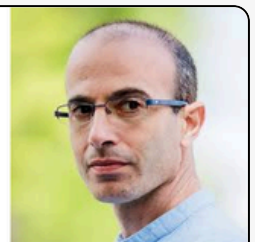
